Minutes of Meeting

- 1. The AoE talk of the 16th January 21 was chaired by Chairman Shishir Chaturvedi. Congratulating on Historic 100th Meet and a Happy New Year. He appreciated the unique AoE Calendar provided to all members and thanked Vice Chairman Naresh Vij and Managing Team for the wonderful initiative.
 - Another initiative by Management Committee is sending Cake to AoEan members on their Birthdays, starting this year.
 - Starting with introduction, wherein each member and guest introducing themselves. It was a wonderful quite emotional evening of sharing and learning with some excellent presentations.
- 2. 1-2-1 Interaction: Secretary Abhineet Seth emphasized focus on 1-2-1 interaction to build trust and nurture relationships and business will automatically follow.

He shared from the 1-2-1 that he did with fellow AoEans Vikas Rajput.
 AoEan Vikas Rajput is an IT Entrepreneur having 2 decades of rich experience, currently Director of ETECH Services Pvt. Ltd. awarded best pharmaceutical software company since 2016, a healthcare software specialist company. His e-health card application is a path breaking innovation. In family, his wife Mamta is a homemaker and he is a proud father of daughter Kritika and son Kartik.

Treasurer Vikas Rajput few days back had 1-2-1 interaction with Internal Speaker AoEan Veerendra Malik. In year 2000, AoEan Veerendra Malik was President of All India Printers Association. His wife is a homemaker, son heads Technicolor Company which manages digital content for Hollywood and daughter heads Photo Monkey which specializes in personalized products.

- Internal Speaker: AoEan Veerendra Malik initially started to look at family business at a very young age, took thru his journey of life. His story started from when his organization was doing key printing jobs in 50s & 60s for important Government Sectors & Army. Key points and learning's from his presentation are:
 - In life, one should go on with the practical situation that is on ground.....in Rome do what Romans do.
 - In 1971 war, he implemented confidential Government orders working hard taking all the challenges it curtailed, till midnight and often continuously for days.
 - Another very important two incidents, he printed brochure overnight or changed contents as required by Government, took the challenges and got the results however impromptu it was
 - In spite of not knowing Russian language, when the opportunity came, he printed the magazine in Russian language by resolving the problem in an innovative way by memorizing shape of characters and using it. The big learning is that you can do any type of job, if you have a will. They could have easily refused the job, not only they did the job well but also got huge orders later on when India-Russia trade & cooperation soared.
 - In England, he saw their printing chronicles and dreamt to do it in India. Initial venture failed, but tried again with learning new technology and now he prints magazines Digital Printing, Printers Yearbook, Print Traveller, Delhi Printer etc.
 - Diversified into Brand "Photo Monkey" promoting personalized products. They do personalized Glassware, Brand Labels and Gifting etc. They also make unique & custom designed Photo Books.
 - Don't give up what you aspire to do, try again and again.

Vice Chairman Naresh Vij thanked AoEan Veerendra Malik for his wonderful presentation, sharing such huge learning's and insights especially about Governmental working.

• **AoE Mentoring Launch** – Mentoring Group Chairman AoEan Veer Sagar dedicated the launch to the 100th Meeting today. AoEan Rajiv Mathur presented the objective which is an extension only of the current AoE objective and explained the process flow.

Objective: To Help AoE members by unlocking the wealth of knowledge and experience within the AoE member community.

Entrepreneur needs to define, Specific Challenge that the business is facing, which will result in a structured plan for its resolution and the mentoring team addresses the problems and mentee reaps the definitive benefit to the business.

Process: Mentee requests Executive Committee on a Specific Problem-> Evaluation by EC team(checking appropriate resources available)-> Mentoring Team Reviews -> Acceptance -> Preliminary Stage (discovery , 6 Weeks) -> Outcome Evaluation -> Intermediate Stage (Detailed,6 weeks) -> Outcome Evaluation -> Advanced Stage (Options,6 weeks) -> Publishing Success story on website.

Chairman Shishir Chaturvedi pressed the Launch button and rolled it up with all round applause. He invited applications from members which EC will forward to Mentoring committee.

Executive Administration will coordinate inputs/suggestions or assist as per requirement.

Founder Chairman Veer Sagar dwelled on history of AoE, AoEan Veer Sagar stated that it was not made on one fine morning but an offshoot of networking forum. Not happy with the rigidity of that networking forum, friends who felt happy with each other's company met occasionally at causal meetings in 2011.
